

Instructions for activating a router of INSYS icom on a Swisscom VDSL connection

You can set up the modular VDSL router MRX 3/5 DSL-A or another MRX basic variant with additional VDSL card (MRcard PD-A) on a VDSL Internet connection of Swisscom in just a few steps. These instructions are a supplement to the Quick Installation Guide MRX DSL that is enclosed with the router or available under <https://www.insys-icom.com/manual#mrx>.

Commission the MRX router as described in the associated Quick Installation Guide. Select in section "D" of the Quick Installation Guides the option "DHCP-Client" and enter the Vendor ID "100008,0001" (Swisscom). Proceed as described in the Quick Installation Guide.

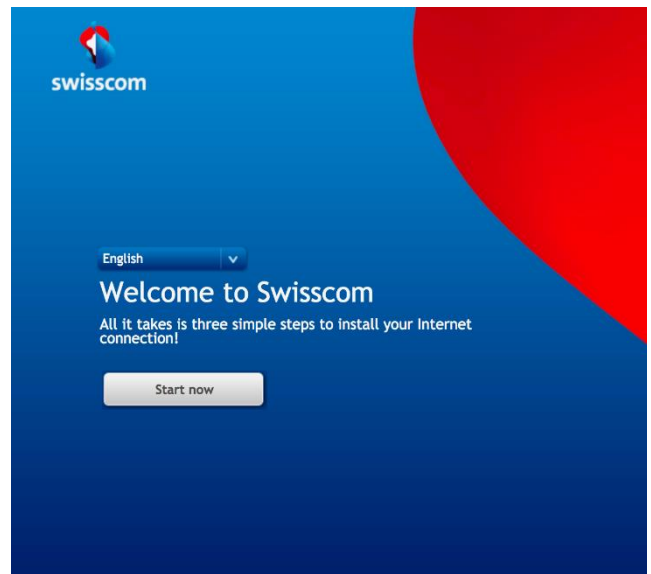


Open your standard browser, enter the address www.swisscom.ch/start and click on "Start now"

DSL registration can only be made if you are connected to the MRX router via network cable and the Internet connection to Swisscom uses this router as gateway.


